



The Calvin J. Peterson Memorial Scholarship

Service 1 Federal Credit Union has established a scholarship program to assist members who plan to continue their education in college programs. Scholarships are offered each year for those taking at least 9 credits in a semester at an accredited institution of the student's choice.

This scholarship program is administered by the Service 1 Federal Credit Union scholarship committee. We seek to involve and assist the private sector in expanding educational opportunities and encouraging educational achievement. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, disability, or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the Calvin J. Peterson Memorial scholarship program must be:

- A member of Service 1 Federal Credit Union or the child or grandchild of a member of Service 1 Federal Credit Union.
- High school or college students who plan to enroll or are already enrolled in an undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college or university.

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$1,000.00 award. Two scholarships will be granted each year. Awards are one-time only and are not renewable. Funds will be applied to the student's tuition.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Service 1 FCU postmarked no later than February 1, 2009. Grade reports are not acceptable. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grand total and current hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken. Applicants will receive acknowledgement of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgement card is not received within three weeks, applicants may call Service 1 FCU to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applicants are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by the Service 1 Federal Credit Union Scholarship Committee.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, and statement of goals and aspirations.

Selection of recipients is made by the Service 1 Federal Credit Union Scholarship Committee. All applicants agree to accept the decision of the committee as final.

Applicants will be notified by March 1, 2009. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship recipients will be notified of their award by March 1, 2009 and money will be disbursed in August 2009. The award money will be mailed directly to the college or university on behalf of the student.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have no obligation to Service 1 Federal Credit Union. They are, however, required to supply the committee with complete transcripts when requested and to notify the committee of any changes of address, school enrollment, or other relevant information.

REVISIONS

Service 1 Federal Credit Union reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
